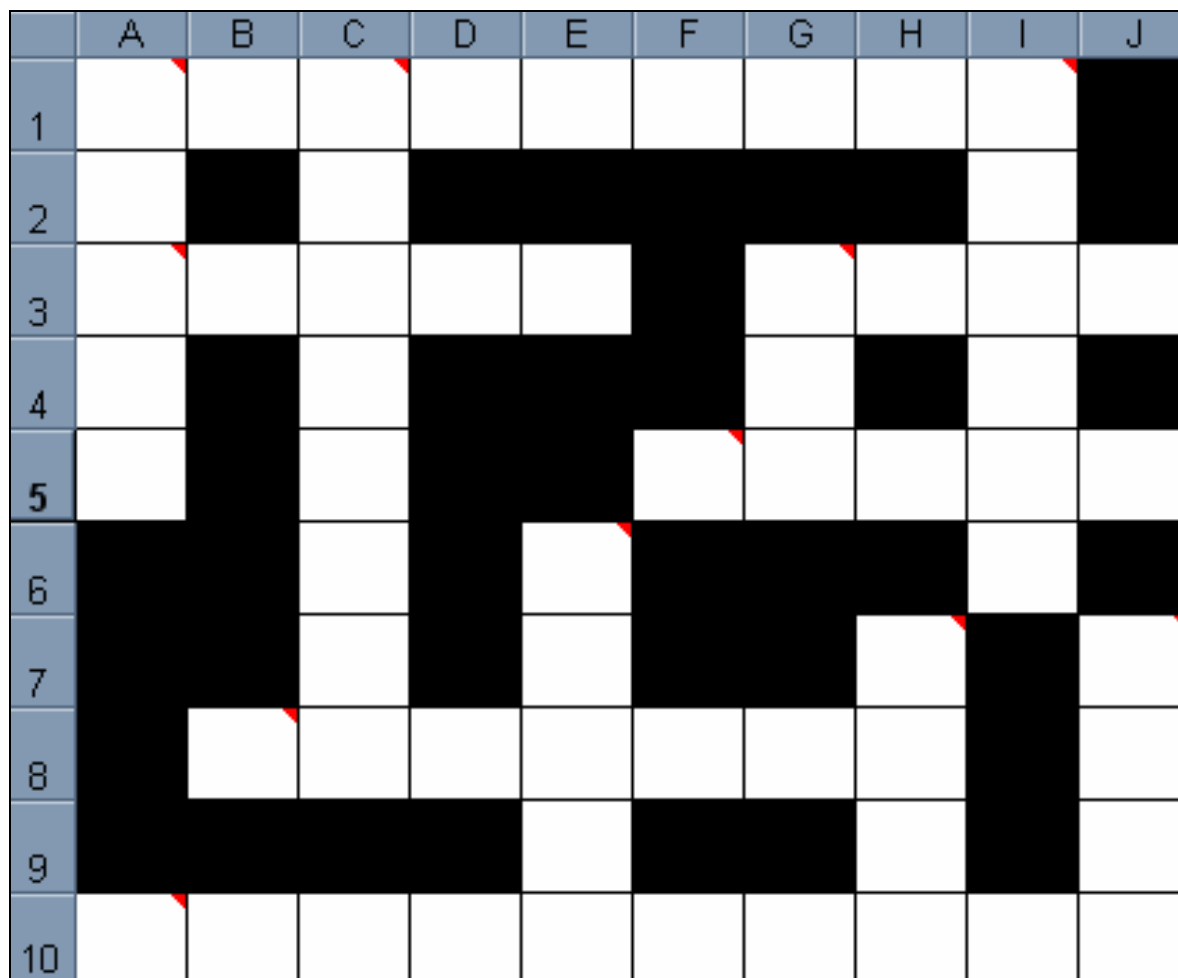


The Singing and the Actor Crossword 1
